On 11/04/2015 at approximately 0548 hours I, Ofc Davis, was dispatched to 4025 Watson Blvd Suite 110, Clyde Armory, in reference to a business alarm. I left police headquarters, and arrived on scene at 0600 hours. I was able to see the back door of the business, from Watson Blvd. It appeared to be closed and not damaged. I continued to the front of the business. The front on the business has windows and glass doors. I observed the left glass door to be damaged. I immediately called for another unit. I looked inside the business, from the front door, and was unable to see anyone inside. Lt. Edwards and Sgt Bish arrived on scene. Sgt Bish's canine made entry into the business. Sgt Bish, Lt. Edwards, and I entered the business. Ofc Wynette from the Centerville Police Department also responded. We cleared the business, and did not find anyone inside. The storage room was still locked. The office was locked. I had Dispatch contact a keyholder.

Tim Campbell arrived on scene. Mr. Campbell was able to turn the alarm off. He unlocked the front door. He was also able to unlock the office door, where the security footage could be accessed. The rifles and pistols are not kept in locked racks. The pistols are kept in glass display cases. The rifles are kept in racks, which are on the south wall of the business. The rifles are not secured in the racks. There is no cable ran through the guns. The store does have a vault. The vault is in the storage room. The storage room is kept locked.

Dispatch advised the point of activation was the left rear motion. The alarm company received the alarm at 0544 hours. They notified the 911 center at 0546 hours. I was dispatched at 0548 hours. I arrived at 0600 hours. Lt. Edwards notified IDC Investigator Hosch. Inv. Hosch arrived on scene. She was able to access the video footage. The time, on the store's security system, appears to be eleven hours and three minutes behind the correct time. Based on this, the suspects are first seen on camera at 0521 hours. The security system's time/date stamp shows it as 1818 hours on 11/03/2015. There are three suspects seen on camera. All three suspects are wearing long sleeves and long pants. They all have their faces covered and are wearing gloves. I was unable to determine an age, sex, or race of the suspects. The suspects are first seen walking along the rear sidewalk of the building. The security camera covers the back door. This sidewalk is on the east side of the building, and runs adjacent to Raffield Tire's parking lot. Raffield Tire does not have any outside cameras. The suspects are seen going off camera, and to the north end of the building. Firehouse Subs is next to Clyde Armory, on the north end of the building. They do not have any outside cameras. All three suspects are seen walking south, a few minutes later. The suspects come back, a few minutes later, and walk to the front of the store. They use a center punch to break the front glass of the left door. One suspect kicks the front glass inside. They then enter the store. The suspects grab several rifles and pistols. They exit the store, and run around the back of the building. One suspect has a backpack on his back. The suspects re-enter the store, approximately three minutes later. They take several more guns. They also take the two cash register drawers. They exit the store at 0546 hours. This is approximately 1843 hours on 11/03/2015 on the security system footage.

Detective Rozier and Sgt Mules responded to the scene. We walked out of the back door of the business. We began walking south, along the sidewalk. We did not see any cameras, on the back of the businesses, that might have picked up our suspects. We did discover fresh boots prints on a wooden pallet. It had been raining for most of the night and morning. There was red dirt on a wooden pallet. The pallet was in the lot of a building under construction. The new building is being constructed in the lot which is directly north of 109 Willie Lee Pkwy. The lot is partially paved with asphalt. The other part of the lot is red dirt. There was standing water and mud in the lot. There were fresh boots prints in the mud. Those prints appeared to be the same as the ones on the pallet. We made contact with two construction workers. They advised it was there first day on the sight. They had just arrived and had not been on that part of the lot. There boot tread did not match the shoe impressions. I also discovered a dark colored bag. The bag was not muddy. It was also dry. It appeared the suspects had parked in this lot, so their vehicle would not be seen on security cameras. Inv. Hosch was able to collect the bag. She also made cast of the shoe wear impressions.

The suspects kept their faces covered and their gloves on while inside. Nine pistols and fifteen rifles were taken.

#### INVESTIGATIVE PROGRESS DETECTIVE BRETT ROZIER

11-04-15

On this date, I was the on call investigator. I was called to the incident location in reference to a burglary. Upon my arrival I observed the front door glass on the left front door shattered. I also observed several guns missing from inside the store. I contacted ATF Agent Lightner, who responded to the scene.

Once C.S.I Hosch was able clear a path to the front of the store, I along with the store manager, Mr. Ryan Hicks, and Mr. Timothy Cambell were able to enter the store. Upon entering the store, it was found that a total of 15 assault rifles and 9 pistols were stolen along with the cash register. Upon reviewing the security video it was found that three suspects entered the store making two separate trips. Note the video is 11 hours off. The suspects are observed on video the first time at 0515 Hrs. Two suspects walk up to the store coming from the rear alley of the store around Firehouse Subs and then to the front door. The suspects look through the glass and then leave the same way that they came. At 0540 Hrs the same two suspects return with a third suspect. It was at this time that one of the suspects uses a glass punch the break the glass on the left side front door. The suspect then kicks the glass which then breaks. All three suspects then enter the store. Two of the suspects steal several assault rifles and the third takes the cash register. Note the suspect who took the cash register had on a book bag and did have bolt cutters. The suspects then exit the store and use the same route behind the store between the alley. Two of the suspects then return a few minutes later and re-enter the store. One of the suspects steals more assault rifles, while the second steals pistols. The suspects then exit the store again using the same route. It is unknown what race the suspects are. The suspect clothing descriptions are as follows. Suspect # 1 black in color shirt, black in color jacket, camo pants, black in color athletic shoes, red in color baclova style mask and gloves. Suspect # 2 black in color shirt, black in color jacket, black in color bandanna style face mask, tan in color camo pants, black gloves and tan boots. Suspect #3 black in color pants, black in color jacket, black in color hood with base ball style hat, black and white in color athletic shoes, and tan in color gloves. This video was downloaded by C.S.I Hosh and placed into evidence.

Upon searching the scene, mud was observed near the front of the store. I then went through the alley behind the incident location. It was at this time that a black in color bag was located along with several shoe impressions near the bag in a construction site. The bag was not wet and due to rain the night prior this suggested that it was left by the suspect. The foot prints lead toward the parking lot of a burned down hotel next to the construction site. Note their are no cameras in this area. I did make contact at the Candlewood Hotel and was able to view the video from this location, which showed a vehicle coming from the parking lot of the burned down hotel and into the parking lot of the hotel. This vehicle appeared to be a dark in color car possibly a Dodge Charger. I also observed this vehicle stop next to another dark in color vehicle, which was parked in the parking lot near Margie Dr. The vehicle appeared to have a passenger exit the vehicle and enter the second vehicle. It is unknown what type of vehicle

the second vehicle is. I then viewed video from the McDonalds which is in front of the hotel. This video showed a black in color Dodge Charger come to the drive thru at 0510 Hrs. The vehicle has blacked out windows and no persons can be seen. Upon getting this information, the video from Clyde Armory was reviewed again. This video showed a black in color Dodge Charger drive in front of the building minutes prior to seeing the suspects on video. This vehicle appeared to be the same vehicle in all three videos. I did collect all of these videos and will place them into evidence.

I did verify that all of the stolen weapons were entered into GCIC, I also placed them into Leads Online and gave a copy of the stolen items with the serial numbers to the local gun and pawn shops.

Later this date, I was advised by Agent Lightner that a similar burglary took place at 645 Cobbham Rd Thomson GA on 11-02-15 at 0540 Hrs. Agent Lightner was emailed photos from the security video from this burglary. At least one of the suspects from this burglary, the suspect in the red mask appears to be the same person.

On this date, I was advised by ATF Agent William Hairston that five of the suspects were taken into custody in Atlanta Ga and that the black in color Dodge Charger was also recovered. I was advised that in the trunk of the charger was a sales tag for the 308 Reaper with the name Clyde Armory on it.

On this date, I was asked to email the photos of the shoe wear impressions to ATF Agent Hairston for comparison with those located on the suspects.
