I received a police radio call to Gebo's, 215 50th st, in reference to an alarm down.

EMP1 works at VAB1.

Upon my arrival, I walked around the property and did not observe any signs of forced entry. I walked back around to the front and waited for a rep to show up. A short time later, EMP1 arrived onscene. EMP1 opened the front door. Ofc. Rodriguez and I went inside to clear the store. Ofc. Rodriguez went towards the west side of the store and I went to the east side. I located broken glass on the floor next to the gun cases and advised Ofc. Rodriguez that it was going to be a good alarm.

Ofc. Rodriguez and I continued to clear the store walking north bound. I located a bar to the emergency exit door on the ground along with the clips that lock it in place. We continued to walk north bound when Ofc. Rodriguez observed a vent from the AC to be hanging down. We then observed a rope hanging out of the AC shaft. It appears that \$1 and \$2 entered the store from the AC on top of the roof. \$1 and \$2 slid down the rope and stole several handguns. \$1 and \$2 then fled the scene through the emergency exit.

\$1 and \$2 entered the store without consent from the owner and stole several firearms.

Ofc. Rodriguez and myself went outside to check inside the fenced in area for any property or evidence. Ofc. Rodriguez got on top of the roof to clear it and check for evidence. Ofc. Rodriguez pulled the rope and pulley up from the roof so it could be turned in as evidence.

Investigator Fish with LPD/ATF arrived onscene due to firearms being stolen.

Investigator Fish located W1 at the stripes across the street. I went to talk to W1. W1 advised he observed a 2002ish Ford F150 single cab pickup, silver in color parked on the northeast corner of Gebo's. W1 advised the truck was parked there for approximately one hour. W1 advised he observed S1 driving the pickup and S2 as a passenger in the pickup. W1 advised the pickup left eastbound on 50th st then north bound on Ave A. W1 advised a couple minutes later the pickup came back south bound on Ave A and west bound on 50th st. W1 advised he never observed anyone get out of the vehicle and did not observe anyone on the roof of Gebo's. After reviewing video from the smoke shop next to Gebo's it does not show any vehicles in the parking lot of Gebo's. However, the video skips around a lot and does not appear to always pick up motion coming from Gebo's.

Gebo's employees were still working on getting inventory on what firearms were stolen. Inv. Fish advised that he would get the listed and enter the firearms as stolen and turn it in as trailing documents.

I placed the rope and pulley in the LPD property room as Evidence.

EMP1 provided me with an estimate on the damaged property.

Ofc. Powell arrived onscene as a CSO and photographed the scene. See his supplement.
