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SUMMARY
I RECEIVED A POLICE RADIO CALL TO GEBOS (215 50TH STREET) IN REFERENCE TO AN ALARM DOWN.

EMP1 IS A MANAGER FOR VAB.

UPON ARRIVAL DAMAGE TO THE SHEET METAL OF THE BUILDING WAS OBSERVED FROM OUTSIDE THE CHAIN LINK FENCE ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE BUILDING. THE CHAINLINK FENCE HAS BARBED WIRE GOING ACROSS THE TOP OF IT. THE DAMAGE APPEARED LARGE ENOUGH FOR ENTRY TO HAVE BEEN GAINED INTO THE BUILDING. I WALKED AROUND THE OUTER CHAINLINK FENCE ALL THE WAY TO WHERE IT STARTS WITH A BRICK WALL. I DID NOT OBSERVE ANY DAMAGE TO THE CHAINLINK FENCE.

A REP (EMP1) ARRIVED ONSCENE AND CONFIRMED THE DAMAGE TO THE SHEET METAL WAS NEW DAMAGE. THE REP UNLOCKED THE FRONT DOOR AND OFC COOK (K9) AND I ENTERED THE BUILDING TO CLEAR IT. WHILE CLEARING THE BUILDING AN AX HANDLE WAS LOCATED INSIDE ONE OF THE EAST DOORS ON THE FLOOR OF THE BUSINESS. TWO DOUBLE DOORS LEADING INTO AN AREA NEAR THE FEED ROOM WHERE DAMAGED. WHILE CLEARING THE FEED ROOM AND APPROACHING THE SECOND EAST DOOR NEAR WHERE THE SHEET METAL WAS DAMAGED I LOCATED A RIFLE (DEL-TON 5.56) ON THE FLOOR. I OBSERVED AN AX HEAD BROKEN OFF AND LAYING NEAR THE EAST DOOR BY THE DAMAGED SHEET METAL. THE DOOR HANDLE WAS ALSO BROKEN OFF THE DOOR.

AFTER CLEARING THE BUILDING I OBSERVED THE GLASS DOORS TO THE GUN CABINETS HAD BEEN PULLED OFF TRACK.

OFC ASHMORE LOCATED A RIFLE (S&W 22) AND A SECOND RIFLE AND MAG (DIAMONDBACK AR 223) IN THE FIELD BEHIND THE BUSINESS.

THERE IS SURVEILANCE CAMERAS AROUND THE BUILDING. SURVEILANCE FOOTAGE SHOWS TWO SUBJECTS (\$1 AND \$2) APPEAR ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE BUILDING INSIDE THE CHAINLINK FENCE FROM THE SOUTH. SURVEILANCE CAMERAS SHOW \$1 AND \$2 CAUSE DAMAGE TO THE DOOR AND SHEET METAL BEFORE ENTERING INTO THE BUSINESS WITHOUT CONSENT. SURVEILANCE CAMERAS SHOW \$1 AND \$2 TRAVEL THROUGH THE STORE TO THE GUN CABINETS AND OBTAIN NUMEROUS RIFLES. SURVEILANCE CAMERAS SHOW \$1 AND \$2 LEAVE THE STORE THE SAME WAY THEY ENTERED. SURVEILANCE CAMERAS SHOW \$1 AND \$2 LEAVING SOUTHBOUND TOWARDS THE BRICK WALL.

EMP1 ADVISED HE DID NOT KNOW HOW TO SAVE THE FOOTAGE BUT WOULD HAVE EMPLOYEES SAVE THE FOOTAGE ON TODAYS DATE AND IT CAN BE OBTAINED BY DETECTIVES ON A LATER DATE AND TIME.

EMP1 WAS ABLE TO TELL THAT THE RUGER PRECISION RIFLE HAD BEEN STOLEN. EMP1 WAS NOT SURE OF THE OTHER RIFLES UNTIL INVENTORY COULD BE DONE. THERE ARE NO SERIAL NUMBERS OR DESCRIPTIONS OF THE POSSIBLE RIFLES AT THIS TIME. I GAVE EMP1 AN ADDITIONAL LOSS FORM.

I TOOK CUSTODY OF THE AX HANDLE FOR POSSIBLE LATENT PRINTS TO BE OBTAINED BY OUR ID SECTION. I TOOK CUSTODY OF THE AX HANDLE. BOTH ITEMS WILL BE TURNED INTO THE PROPERTY ROOM AS EVIDENCE.

NO FIREARMS ARE ENTERED INTO TCIC/NCIC AS STOLEN AT THIS TIME DUE TO LACK OF SERIAL NUMBERS AND DESCRIPTIONS.

OFC FUNK RESPONDED AS A CSO AND TOOK PHOTOGRAPHS. SEE SUPPLEMENT.

S1 AND S2 APPEAR TO HAVE THEIR FACES COVERED AND ARE WEARING GLOVES DURING THE BURGLARY.
