He advised that he thinks "Tay's brother is 18 and Tay is 16". I asked him if "Tay" still lived next door. Teasley stated "yea, but he's locked up". I asked him about "Tay's brother" and he stated that "he passed away".

was the first time in this place. I asked him who they met and he stated that he knows them by "Nate and Sincere". I asked him if those were nicknames or if that was their real names. He advised that he thinks those are their real names. I asked him if Nate and Sincere were males or females. He advised that they were both black males. I asked how old that they were and he thinks Nate is about 17 or 18 and Sincere is "grown, he has a baby". I asked him if these two were part of the "Blitz gang". He advised that they were. I asked Teasley what area "Blitz" calls their own and he advised "The Plex", I asked Teasley if they gave all the guns to these two. He stated that "Tay and Lo" put the guns on the couch. I asked him if he had any of the guns and he stated, "not at that time". I asked him how they carried them in to the building. He advised that they were in a bag. I asked what kind of bag, and he stated that it was a duffel bag. I asked him what color the bag was and he could not remember. I asked Teasley if they had the long guns in the house as well and he stated that they did. I again asked him if he kept any of the guns and this time he stated that he kept "one gun". I asked him what gun he kept and he stated it was a "43X". I asked Teasley if they received anything in exchange for the guns and he stated "no, they just let them pick". I asked him if they left with any guns after Sincere and Nate picked what they wanted, and he stated that they "left with some guns, but there was not alot left". Det Soros showed Teasley pictures of the two white long guns that were stolen. Teasley confirmed that Nate and Sincere kept both of the white guns (white Vector 45 rifle and the white Rock Island VR80 12 ga.) but that he was not sure where the other rifle went.

After leaving "the plex" they go back to Tay and Lo's house (9306 Columbia Ave.). Teasley stated that "they took" the guns inside. I asked him if their mom was awake and he stated that she was asleep. I asked him if he went inside with them and he stated that he did. I asked him what they did with the guns and he stated that they took them upstairs and put them on the bed in Tay's room. I asked Teasley if Tay lives at that house and he stated "yea, basically". I asked him what they did next and he stated, "they put the guns in the closet". I asked him what he did next and he advised that he thinks they went to sleep. Teasley stated that he slept til about 9-10 and then went back to his house. I asked him if he brought the gun that he kept to his house and he advised that he left it at Tay's house.

He stated that he thinks "th ey left if somewhere, I don't know where they put it". I asked him how he retrieved the gun that he kept . He stated that he went over to their house, but they were gone. They left the gun that Teasley took in a "cabinet thing" and Teasley stated that he took it. I asked him if someone let him in "Tay and Lo's" house or if he just went in. He stated that the door was open.

I asked him what he did after he retrieved the gun. He stated that he didn't know. He then stated that he "thinks he got in to the car". I asked him whose car and he replied, "I don't know". On 06-03-21 at approximately 1035 hours Officer Grant VanFossen made a traffic stop on a vehicle being driven by Brandon Priddle. Officers had just been out on a trespassing call involving Brandon on Spring Valley West. A resident on Spring Valley West had called to advise that Brandon was on their property and he was unwanted at that location. There had been a protection order in place in the past but the order was no longer in effect. Officers made contact with Brandon at 3507 Spring Valley West where we learned that Brandon had an active felony warrant and a suspended drivers license. The entering agency would not take on the warrant. Brandon was asked to leave per the homeowner. Officers allowed Brandon to leave his car on the street. He was transported to Circle K North to wait for a ride to pick him and the car up.

Brandon was later observed walking back toward Spring Valley West. Officer Houser had been in the area but left to take a call. The original caller called back to advise that Brandon was walking toward his house and the caller was leaving the area. Officer VanFossen responded to the area and located the vehicle leaving the neighborhood.

Officer VanFossen made the traffic stop and a short time later was requesting another cruiser due to subject resisting. A short time later Officer VanFossen advised that subject was detained. On Scene Officer VanFossen advised that Brandon was reaching for something in the console area of his vehicle and refused to show his hands after commands to do so. Officer advised that he grabbed subjects arm because he was concerned that he might be reaching for a weapon. Officer pulled subject out of vehicle and placed him on the ground and was able to detain without much further resistance. Officer VanFossen advised that subject had put something in his mouth, which was believed to be marijuana. I could smell a strong odor of marijuana as I walked past Officer VanFossen 's cruiser where the subject was seated. Both Officer VanFossen and Brandon advised that they were uninjured. Brandon confirmed a couple times that he had only placed marijuana into his mouth. I could observe no injuries on Brandon. Brandon was cooperative on scene and was issued a summons for DUS. The vehicle inventory was conducted and vehicle towed. A couple knives were observed on the drivers side door arm rest. A plastic baggie and marijuana residue was located in the back of car 18 where Brandon had spit the items out of his mouth. Brandon was given a ride into Akron by Officer VanFossen.

On 06-04-21 at 0840 hours I reviewed Officer VanFossen's body cam footage. Officer approaches subject in a professional manner. Subject can be observed concealing right hand on the right side of his body and not complying with instructions to show his hand. I could hear the concern in officers voice as officer reaches for subjects arm. Officer ends up grabbing subjects left arm and pulling him straight out of the vehicle overcoming some mild initial resistance. Subject is taken out of the vehicle while low to the ground and goes down on his stomach rather gently. Officer brings both hands behind subjects back and is able to hold them in place with one hand as subject is now cooperating. Subject is placed into handcuffs and they discuss what subject put into his mouth. Subject admitted to placing marijuana into his mouth. Subject is rolled onto his side and stood up rather quickly.
