On the listed date and time I responded to an alarm drop at Summit Armory. Prior to that I was doing a business check on Granger road. On my way to Summit Armory, there was no traffic that passed me as I was northbound on N. Cleveland Massillon Rd. As I arrived on scene, the alarm was still going off and the listed car (Kia Optima) was smashed into the building. The Kia was still running and there appeared to be no one around.

The building was searched by myself, Sgt Griffith, and a Richfield Police Officer and the store was clear. While searching the store, I noticed a handgun (Glock 22 serial #BTSC846) on the floor of an aisle. One of the glass displays of handguns was smashed. Beside the display, there was a hammer on the floor. The top two rows of the display were empty of handguns. There was also three empty spaces on the wall where rifles are displayed.

The surrounding area was searched. A handgun (Glock 19 serial # BYMV407) and a handgun display holder was found outside on ground. They were located on the south side of the building. There were also tire marks in the grass behind the store.

The Kia Optima owner was contacted by dispatch and it appears to be stolen out of Cleveland. The steering column was peeled and a USB cord was connected. Photographs were taken with a flash of the scene. Body camera U-319 was activated during the search of the building.

I noticed that the ignition had been damaged and that there was a white USB phone cord inserted in to the area where a key would normally go. The USB side of the plug was inserted in to the steering column. The car was still running at this time. I noticed a black and mild wrapper on the floor of the drivers side and a orange Bic lighter in the same location. I decided to take these items as evidence in the event that they were not the owners. I also took the USB cord out of the ignition as evidence.

Upon walking in to the main showroom of the store, I noticed that one of the display cases had been smashed and that there was a yellow and black hammer on the floor in front of the damaged case. Upon watching the video of the incident, it appears that the hammer on the floor was the same one that was used to smash the display case. That too was taken as evidence. Inside the display case it appeared that all the guns were missing on the top two shelves, but there were still guns on the bottom of the case. I also noticed three empty spaces on the wall, behind the handgun display cases, where rifles and shotguns are displayed.

I proceeded to canvass the store to look for anything that may have been dropped during the theft, and also walked around the building. Nothing, other than the Glock handgun that was dropped on the south side of the building, was located. The green sachel that was located in the rear lot of the building was not involved in this theft as it belongs to an employee who accidentally left it outside.

Teasley was read, and shown, his Miranda Rights. He verbally acknowledged that he understood each of his rights, and I had him initial and sign the Miranda Form stating that he understood his rights and was willing to voluntarily speak with me.

Teasley stated that he used to attend Glenville High School up to the 12th grade.

Teasley advised that he reads and understands the English language.

Teasley advised that he was not under the influence of alcohol or drugs at this time.

I had Det. Soros sign the Miranda Form as a witness.

I advised Teasley that I wanted to speak with him about a gun store that was broken in to in Bath, Ohio. He was advised that the suspects drove a stolen car through the front window and then left the store. I asked him if he knew anything about that. Teasley replied, "Yes". I asked him to talk to me about what happened that day. I asked that he start with the cars being stolen and go from there.

I asked Teasley how they all met up that day. He stated that "they rolled up on me". I asked him who was with him that day. He replied, "me, Tay, and Tay's brother". I asked him what "Tay's" full name is and he stated that he does not know his name. I asked him if he knew his last name, and again, he stated that he did not know it. I confirmed that he stated that it was "Tay and Tay's brother" and he replied, "Yea". I asked him where "Tay and Tay's brother" live. He pointed over his shoulder and said "right here". Detective Soros asked him, "next door" and Teasley advised "um hm". The house next door is 9306 Columbia Ave. which is the home of Leontae C. Hunter (5/20/2006) and Lawrence M. McKissic Jr. (3/4/2004). McKissic is deceased as of 11/19/2022 (Cleveland Report number 2022-00338930). I asked him if he knew how old "Tay and Tay's brother" are. I asked him what her name is and he stated that he didn't know and that "she's really small". Det. Soros asked him if her name was "Lay Lay", and Teasley stated he didn't know. He then said the name "Adora or Dora" could be her name, but he didn't know. He added that he knows her as "Adora". I ask Teasley, so your in "Tay's" house with "Adora" and "Tay and Tay's" brother roll up outside? He acknowledged that was correct. I asked him what kind of vehicle the two of them were in. Teasley stated, "it was a Kia". I asked him if he knew what kind of Kia it was and he stated it was a "Sportage". I asked him what color the Kia was and he stated "black". He also advised that it was a 4 door vehicle. I asked him what time he was picked up and he stated "it was like early morning". I asked him what he meant by "early morning" and whether he meant after midnight or early like now early. He stated that after midnight early. I asked him if it was possibly a Optima, and he stated that it was. I asked him if he knew what color it was and he advised that he thought it was burgundy.

I asked him if he knew if the car that "Tay" picked him up in was stolen or not. I asked him why "Lo" picked that store that was 30 minutes away from Cleveland. I asked Teasley if he had ever been to that gun store before and he advised that he has not. Teasley claims that he was not aware of the plans this evening until "Lo" explained it to him. Teasley also stated that at that point, it was too late for him to get out of that car.

I asked Teasley about the mask he wore in the gun store. I asked him if he brought it with him or if it was in the car. He advised that the mask was "their mask, not mine". I asked him who provided him the mask and he stated, "Lo". I asked Teasley if they immediately went to the gun store after stealing the 2nd Kia. He advised that was correct.

I ask him what happened at the store. Teasley advised that "they pulled in the back and they sat there for a minute, then they pulled around, then ran through it and everything". I asked him who was driving the Kia Optima that was used to drive through the window. He thought about it for a minute and then stated "Lo" drove the car in to the window.

(This is not correct as, on the video, we can tell that Teasley is the driver of the Optima that was driven through the window. This is addressed in a second interview at the Cleveland Police Department, 2nd District Office).

I asked Teasley about the mask he was wearing, and what it looked like. He thought that it was white, but wasn't sure. I asked him "Lo was driving the Optima that went through the store, where were you guys when Lo went through the front window". He advised that he and "Tay" were standing up front when "Lo" drove through the window. I asked him what he did once the car was drove through the window. Teasley stated, "we robbed all the guns". I asked him to be more specific of his role in the theft and he replied, "the handguns". Teasley then stated that he "went in, because he had to smash it for me". I asked him, "smash that what" and Teasley stated, "smash the glass". I asked him who smashed the glass and he advised, "Tay, he smashed the glass and we grabbed all the handguns". After leaving "the plex" they go back to Tay and Lo's house (9306 Columbia Ave.). Teasley stated that "they took" the guns inside. I asked him what they did with the guns and he stated that they took them upstairs and put them on the bed in Tay's room. I asked Teasley if Tay lives at that house and he stated "yea, basically". Det. Soros asked for the password to Teasleys phone. He advised "9308, my address".

I asked Teasley if he could provide me with any more information about the guns or the location of the remaining guns. He replied, "there not stored, they got the guns on them". I asked him, "the Blitz group" and he stated "um hm".

I asked Teasley about the abandoned house across the street and if he knew if anything was in that house. He stated "nah nah, they had nothing to do with it". Det. Soros asked if Tay put the guns in the "bando" (slang for abandoned house). He answered, "if they did, I wouldn't know, but I don't think so". Teasley stated that the last time he was in that house was about 6-7 months ago. Det. Soros asked him how they get in and he stated that the door is open. I asked him if there was anything in that house related to this case and he stated, "not that I know".

Det. Soros asked Teasley if anyone from Blitz has reached out to him. He stated, "there not going to ask me that". Soros asked if Tay or Lo were actively part of Blitz. Off duty Cleveland Officer Renshaw #413 was working a extra detail at this store and was watching the males on CCTV. Renshaw reported that she noticed the 3 suspects together outside the store and that one of them had what appeared to be a knife or screwdriver in his hand. The three were also reported to have been pulling on door handles of cars in the parking lot. CPD officers arrived on scene and PO Renshaw notified him that the suspects had seen him and were walking away. The patrol unit spotted two of the suspects, who were identified as Zaveeyon Teasley and Tyriq White, and took them in to custody. Teasley had a flat head screwdriver in the front pocket of his hoodie and a black Iphone in his pants pocket. White was acting very nervous and when he was patted down, a handgun was located in the groin area of White.

The gun, a Glock 26 Gen 5 S/N AGPU157 was loaded with 13 9MM bullets in the magazine and 1 in the chamber. This was a gun that was stolen from the Summit Armory breaking and entering on 11/3/2022 (paragraph 3).

While on scene, the third suspect (Leonte Hunter) walked up to the officers claiming that he was just at Walmart with his mom and that she had to leave for an emergency and was going to pick him up later. Hunter stated that he was not involved with whatever the other two boys were doing, but PO Renshaw advised that he definitely was with them at the time they were trying to get in to cars in the lot. Hunter was patted down and 2 packs of Marijuana gummies and a bag of suspected marijuana was located.

Review of the Walmart tapes shows the three arrived at Walmart in a stolen KIA that was parked at Taco Bell. Teasley was the driver, White was front seat passenger, and Hunter was back seat passenger on passenger side.

Teasley and White both had a Iphone USB charger on their person.

All three were arrested for complicity, possession criminal tools, and RSP. White was additionally charged with carrying a concealed weapon.

SA Phillips asked him, "who is this" and Teasley responded "that's Tay". SA Phillips asked him who "Tay" was, and if it was Leontae Hunter, and Teasley stated that he "don't know him like that". SA Phillips then pointed to the one suspect that was not wearing a mask and Teasley responded, "that's his brother". SA Phillips then pointed to the one wearing the clear mask and stated, "and that you, right? Teasley didn't verbally answer that question.

SA Phillips asked him if they drove directly to the gun store after stealing the 2nd car. Teasley responded, "yea". I asked Teasley who was in the drivers seat of the KIA Optima at the time it was parked in front of the gun store, prior to being driven in to the store. Teasley responded, "that's what's his name, that Lo". SA Phillips asked again, as he pointed to the Optima, who's driving this? Again, Teasley stated "Lo". I asked him, "Lo drove the car through the front of the store" and Teasley stated, "Yea". SA Phillips showed him a picture of all three suspects from the store, and went through them, "here is Tay, Lo, and there is only one other person". Teasley responded, "well I didn't drive the car down there though". I asked him, you drove it through the window, right? He responded, "Yea". SA Phillips shows Teasley the video of the car being driven through the window and shows him the portion of the video of the driver of the car getting out. He asks, that you right? Teasley advised that it was.

SA Phillips then asked Teasley if they loaded all the guns in to the stolen KIA Sportage and drove back up to the projects. Teasley stated, "Yea". SA Phillips asked what happened to the KIA Sportage after they went back to Cleveland. He really didn't answer that, but stated "they had the car" and that he did not see it after they went back to Leontae's house that morning. Teasley then started talking about "Tay's people" dealt with the stolen Sportage, but he claims he does not know them. SA Phillips asked Teasley who was in the back seat of the Sportage on the way back to Cleveland and Teasley advised that he was. SA Phillips asked him if he was taking tags off the guns, and Teasley stated, "No, I didn't take no tags off".

At this point SA Phillips showed Teasley video of another car being stolen. He asked him who was in the video. Teasley advised that the person in the video was not him, but stated that he was there. He advised that the person in the video is "Tay, but I was there though, in the other car". SA Phillips asked

On 06-03-21 at approximately 1035 hours Officer Grant VanFossen made a traffic stop on a vehicle being driven by Brandon Priddle. Officers had just been out on a trespassing call involving Brandon on Spring Valley West. A resident on Spring Valley West had called to advise that Brandon was on their property and he was unwanted at that location. There had been a protection order in place in the past but the order was no longer in effect. Officers made contact with Brandon at 3507 Spring Valley West where we learned that Brandon had an active felony warrant and a suspended drivers license. The entering agency would not take on the warrant. Brandon was asked to leave per the homeowner. Officers allowed Brandon to leave his car on the street. He was transported to Circle K North to wait for a ride to pick him and the car up.

Brandon was later observed walking back toward Spring Valley West. Officer Houser had been in the area but left to take a call. The original caller called back to advise that Brandon was walking toward his house and the caller was leaving the area. Officer VanFossen responded to the area and located the vehicle leaving the neighborhood.

Officer VanFossen made the traffic stop and a short time later was requesting another cruiser due to subject resisting. A short time later Officer VanFossen advised that subject was detained. On Scene Officer VanFossen advised that Brandon was reaching for something in the console area of his vehicle and refused to show his hands after commands to do so. Officer advised that he grabbed subjects arm because he was concerned that he might be reaching for a weapon. Officer pulled subject out of vehicle and placed him on the ground and was able to detain without much further resistance. Officer VanFossen advised that subject had put something in his mouth, which was believed to be marijuana. I could smell a strong odor of marijuana as I walked past Officer VanFossen's cruiser where the subject was seated. Both Officer VanFossen and Brandon advised that they were uninjured. Brandon confirmed a couple times that he had only placed marijuana into his mouth. I could observe no injuries on Brandon. Brandon was cooperative on scene and was issued a summons for DUS. The vehicle inventory was conducted and vehicle towed. A couple knives were observed on the drivers side door arm rest. A plastic baggie and marijuana residue was located in the back of car 18 where Brandon had spit the items out of his mouth. Brandon was given a ride into Akron by Officer VanFossen.

Officer ends up grabbing subjects left arm and pulling him straight out of the vehicle overcoming some mild initial resistance. Subject is taken out of the vehicle while low to the ground and goes down on his stomach rather gently. Officer brings both hands behind subjects back and is able to hold them in place with one hand as subject is now cooperating. Subject is placed into handcuffs and they discuss what subject put into his mouth. Subject admitted to placing marijuana into his mouth. Subject is rolled onto his side and stood up rather quickly.
